

The following COVID protocols will be implemented for on-site camps:

- Check-in and Check-out will be done outside on the porch by the front doors. Temperature checks and daily health screenings for campers at check-in.
- The classroom will be set-up to encourage campers to remain 6' apart whenever inside. Cloth face coverings are required for all campers while indoors, per the Governor's Executive Order. Campers will be required to wear face masks outdoors when social distancing cannot be observed.
- Classroom Capacity at 50% allows for 20 participants maximum in Clearwater Classroom; however, camps will be limited to 8 participants plus 2 staff (10 total)
- Handwashing will be frequent and hand sanitizer stations are located throughout the classroom
- Campers will provide their own food for lunches; no communal food or snacks will be provided
- Campers will not be allowed to touch or handle any of the Aquarium's animal ambassadors. No communal/sharing of props, biofacts, crafts, etc.; each child will be provided with individual items for use and discovery
- At the end of the day, staff will wipe all surfaces, props, crafts, etc. used by campers with disinfectant to insure cleanliness
